

Independence Day +1 Rules

- ***No glass containers are allowed in City of Amarillo parks.***
- ***Only approved Motorized vehicles are allowed on the grass or park walkways.***
- ***Animals must be kept on a leash at all times.***
- ***Only approved vendors allowed in the park.***
- ***Patrons may not enter an area posted as "closed" or use any area in violation of posted notices, barricades or fences.***
- ***Parks and Recreation is not responsible for unattended chairs, blankets and other items left in the park or any lost or stolen items. Items found in the park after the event will be disposed of immediately.***
- ***Dispose trash in waste disposal containers to help keep your park clean.***
- ***Patrons must abide by no parking signs or will be towed at their own expense.***
- ***No hobbyist drones allowed.***
- ***Personal fireworks, including bottle rockets, sparklers & smoke bombs not permitted in the park.***
- ***Music must be kept at a reasonable level so as to not disturb others around you. No music can be played during the concerts.***
- ***No dumping coals, grease or hot materials into trash cans.***
- ***No tents/umbrellas in the area near the stage (concert viewing area).***
- ***No open flame grilling near the stage (concert viewing area) or within ten feet from any canopies, tents, stages, and all other combustible structures.***
- ***We encourage citizens to stake down their tents with stakes no longer than 8".***
